

MIDDLE SCHOOL

BACK TO SCHOOL NIGHT will be held Thursday, August 19th, 2010 from 6:00 to 8:00 p.m. for all students!

Every effort is being made to ensure the most efficient use of middle school education time. Again this year there will be a graded (S or U) intervention period for all students taught by qualified teachers. Students will be participating in extended periods of language arts (English & Literature will be separate grades) in the 7th and 8th grades. The 5th and 6th grade will have recess prior to lunch daily and vary slightly in length from the 7th and 8th grade schedules.

School begins at 8:12 each day. The first day of school will be August 23rd. Students arriving to their classroom after the 8:12 bell will be counted tardy. Students must report to the principal's office to obtain a tardy slip. Excessive tardiness will result in court action. Parents should notify the office at 773-9854 prior to 9:30 a.m. of a student's absence. Students are not permitted in the hallways prior to 8:05 a.m. All students must report to the JH gymnasium upon arrival prior to 8:05 if not eating breakfast. Breakfast begins at 7:50a.m.

LOCKERS for the 7th and 8th grade will be assigned on their class schedule. 5th and 6th grade will use cubbies that will be located in their intervention room which is the last period of the day. 8th will have their same lockers as the previous year.

FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL

On the first day of school all 5th and 6th graders should report directly to their homeroom which is their first period class. 7th and 8th graders report directly to the middle/jh school gymnasium.

FOOTBALL

Middle School football practice will be Mon-Wed-Fri for the week of August 16th. Athletes should report to the high school football field at 5:00 p.m. and be seated in the bleachers. After physical forms have been collected, athletes will report to the practice field for conditioning. Come prepared in shorts, cleats, etc. Students should be picked up at the field at 7:00.
