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Eligibility

Applicants must reside in Chillicothe or Ross County, or must use Chillicothe as a legal residence if attending an out-of-town college. High school senior applicants must intend to declare an art or art education major and college students must be a declared art or art education major to be eligible. Applicants may apply for the scholarship for a maximum of 3 years.

Submission Instructions

Submit 5 to 10 images of your BEST 2-D or 3-D artwork. Please do not submit poor quality images! We also require that you submit one matted 2-D piece of original artwork. Mark this piece with your name, address, telephone number, title of work, and medium. You must include the completed inventory list provided in this brochure for the CD images. The CAL takes no responsibility for damage or loss of submissions.

Delivery of Application Materials and Artwork

Clearly labeled application packets and artwork must be delivered by June 1 to 59 West Main Street #1 upstairs (gray building with green shutters across from the Chillicothe Gazette). Work may be dropped off 1-2 days prior to the deadline only.

Application Review

Applications will be reviewed by the Scholarship Committee which is comprised of CAL members. Judging is based on talent and potential, including timeliness, presentation, content and ability to follow directions. Written notification of scholarship recipients will be received in the month of June.

Pick-up of Artwork

Original artwork will be available for pick-up at the drop-off location by June 10 and no later than June's end. Call ahead 779-6863 to make arrangements, if necessary.

Proof of Enrollment

A copy of an acceptance letter from the Fine Arts or Art Education department showing proof of current enrollment in the curriculum must be received by the league prior to the award of scholarship money.

Presentation of the Award

We invite the recipients to attend the September Chillicothe Art League meeting where the league may personally present the scholarship check. The CAL meets the first Tuesday of each month beginning in September at the Pump House in Yoctangee Park. We do not meet in January, July or August.
