### **Drop Off and Pick Up Procedures**

Parents dropping off their children will enter the school lot at the Sulphur Spring Road entrance by the superintendent's office and then drive in front of the school. Please pull forward to the elementary drop off zone in front of the elementary. Make sure your child is seated on the passenger side in order to be able to get out of the car quickly. Mrs. Myers or Mrs. Congrove will be on the sidewalk to make sure your child gets into the school safely. Other staff will be standing in the hallway to help direct students to their classrooms. If you need to bring your child in you must park in the lot in front of the playground and walk to the front door. Parents are to drop their children off at the end of the grade level hallway except for kindergarteners the first nine weeks.

The elementary doors will be unlocked at **2:55 PM** for those parents that wish to pick up their child after school. Pick up students are released at 3:08 PM. Please pick up your child in the marked designated areas. If you forget to send a note that you are picking up your child, please call the office **no later than 2:30 PM.**
