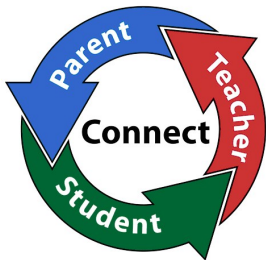
Kroger Rewards
