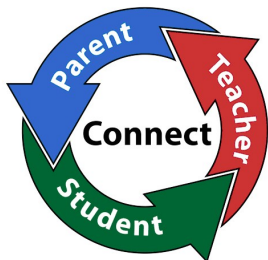
## Kroger Rewards
