



PBIS

Today is the kick off for the PBIS program we will be incorporating in the elementary this year. Positive Behavior Intervention and Supports is a program that teaches students how to behave appropriately. Rewards and other incentives/recognition will be given. It is our hope to see our Little Pioneers **Be Respectful, Be Responsible, and Be Safe.** Kindness is our theme this year. These lessons will be reinforced everyday with our students. Our staff has high expectations for our students. We hope that you will carry out these expectations at home. **Being consistent, firm, and fair are three ways to help our children exhibit the desired outcomes.**

How do you help at home? PBIS is about changing the environment, not the child. Follow these steps at home:

- Decide what behavior you want to change.
- Teach the behavior.
- Practice the correct behavior by role-playing.
- Reinforce the behavior when done correctly.
- Enforce logical consequences. (Throwing papers on floor...pick them up, disrespect...apologize and tell what should have been said, etc.)
