**Childhood/Adult
Immunizations**

- ◆ **NO** appointment necessary.
- ◆ A parent/guardian **must** be present with children under the age of 18 years.
- ◆ **NO** office co-pay for insurances.
- ◆ Your child's physician and school nurse have **access** to all immunizations given at the Ross County Health District clinic through the state database.
- ◆ Please **bring** a copy of your child's immunization record and insurance information.
- ◆ **Free** Ice Cream Cone Certificate sponsored by McDonalds (while supplies last).

Immunizations for Children:

The Ross County Health District offers **all** childhood immunizations including those for infants at 2 months, 4 month, 6 months, 12 months, and 15 months.

Immunization
Requirements for
Kindergarten Attendance**

- ◇ **DTaP/DT:** Five (5) DTaP, DT, or any combo. If the fourth dose is properly spaced and administered after the 4th birthday, a 5th dose is not required.
- ◇ **Polio:** Four (4) doses of IPV; the FINAL dose must be administered on or after the 4th birthday regardless the number of previous doses.
- ◇ **MMR:** Two (2) doses of MMR. Dose 1 must be administered on or after the first birthday. The second dose must be administered at least 28 days after dose 1.
- ◇ **HEP B:** Three (3) doses of Hepatitis B. The second dose must be administered at least 28 days after the first dose. The third dose must be given at least 16 weeks after the first dose and at least 8 weeks after the second dose. The last dose of the series (third or fourth), must not be administered before age 24 weeks.
- ◇ **Varicella:** Two (2) doses of varicella vaccine must be administered prior to entry. Dose 1 must be administered on or after the first birthday. The second dose should be administered at least three (3) months after dose 1; however, if the second dose is administered at least 28 days after first dose, it is considered valid.

Immunization
Requirements for
Middle School/High School Students**

◇ **Tdap**

Grades 7-12: One dose of Tdap vaccine must be administered prior to entry.

◇ **MCV4 (Meningococcal)**

Grade 7: One dose of meningococcal (serogroup A, C, W, and Y) vaccine must be administered prior to entry.

Grade 12: Two (2) doses of meningococcal (serogroup A, C, W, and Y) vaccine must be administered prior to entry.*

* Recommended MCV4 minimum interval of at least eight (8) weeks between dose one (1) and dose two (2). **If the first (1st) dose of MCV4 was administered on or after the 16th birthday, a second (2nd) dose is not required.**

Immunizations for Adults:

Hepatitis A, Hepatitis B, Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (MMR), Meningitis, Pneumococcal, Shingles, Tetanus, Diphtheria, and Pertussis (Td, Tdap), Varicella (Chicken Pox).

Flu vaccine for all ages will be offered beginning mid to late September.
