LATE WORK POLICY- I will no longer be accepting late work. It was a mess trying to keep up with students turning in work at different times and giving deducted grades because of it. Instead, I have a solution that I deem fair for everyone involved.

I will be giving each student a CITIZENSHIP grade each nine weeks. This is a grade that consists of a bank of bonus points (the point value will be different each nine weeks to weigh correctly with the overall grade point value each quarter). The bank DEPLETES in value with every MISSING assignment you have. If you still turn in your late assignment (completed and up to standard), your CITIZENSHIP grade will remain at full value (Note: you will still receive a zero for the assignment, but turning it in will keep your bonus points up). This will help your grades in a few different ways:

- 1) If you turn in all work on time, you will get bonus points on top of your final grade.
- 2) If you miss a deadline, you can still help your grade by turning in your work to keep your bonus points up
- 3) If you completely miss one assignment, your bonus points can take its place in value that one time without turning it in.

● THE CATCH ●- CITIZENSHIP points will be a different point value each nine weeks, but they will usually be a range of 15-30 points depending on the point value load of the quarter. They will not make up for a major assignment (usually 50+ points) or an exam. There will also be no curving final grades of any exam/writing assignment/project taken in this class because of this.

● EXCEPTIONS ● - If an emergency arises, which I understand happens, you may *email* me (do not leave a private comment on Google Classroom) PRIOR TO THE DUE DATE TIME to ask for an extension. Please address as best as possible the reason for the extension. I like to think I am a very understanding person, but I am also a person that will take all factors into account to grant you an extension on particular assignments.
